Knights show the sum of cells that they attack. If a knight attacks another knight, the knight counts as zero. Knight cells contain no digit.

In these puzzles, fill each of the grids with digits from 1 to 7 such that each row, column, and shape (plus each of the two disjoint sets -1 per grid) contains each digit once. The numbers outside the grid are the sum of the first 2 digits in the row or column.
