

Consecutive Plus X Sudoku

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Instructions

In each shape sudoku grid, fill each row, column, and dark-outlined shape* with one of each digit from 1 to 9 with no repeats.

In addition to a handful of givens, the puzzles contain two clue types:

An X denotes a pair of cells that sum to 10.

A bar denotes cells which contain consecutive digits. (e.g. 1 / 2, 2 / 3 ... 8 / 9)

All possible clues are given in this set. In other words, two cells with no symbol between them are neither consecutive nor sum to 10.

* In the sixth puzzle, one group of 9 cells form a disjoint set.
