


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Instructions

In this set of puzzles, fill each row, column, and shape in each grid with the digits 1 through 5, without repetition.


The darkened lines that form the shapes also split each row and column into multi-digit numbers, and the sums of several rows and columns are provided. See the below diagram for an example.








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










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Example
