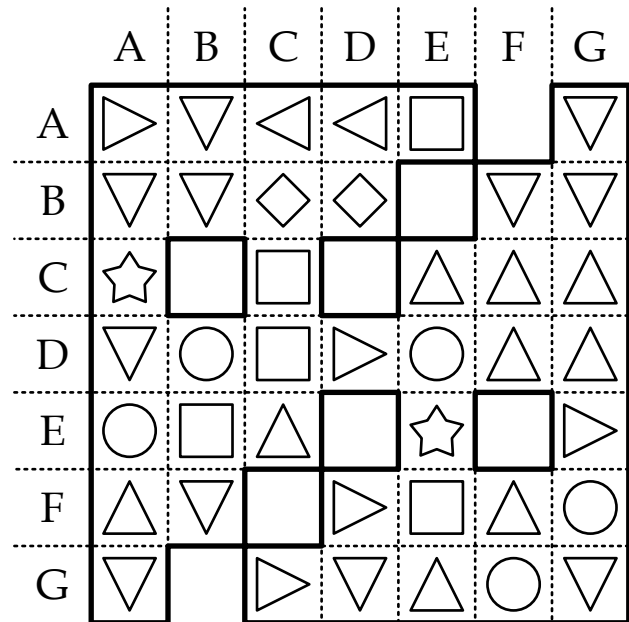
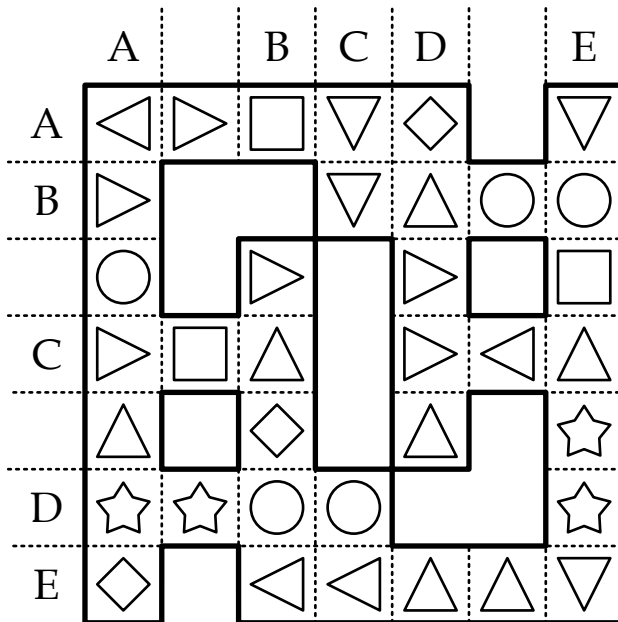


# the griddle Shapeword
