Thanks for solving.

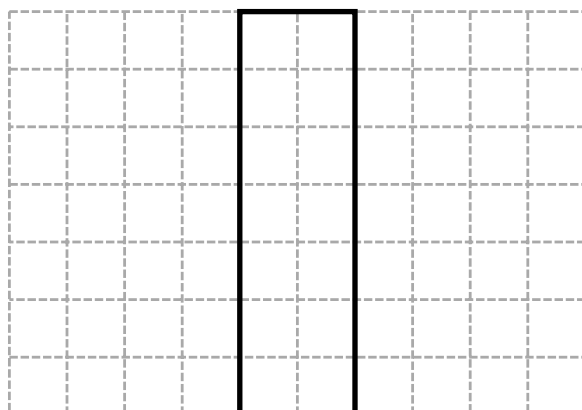
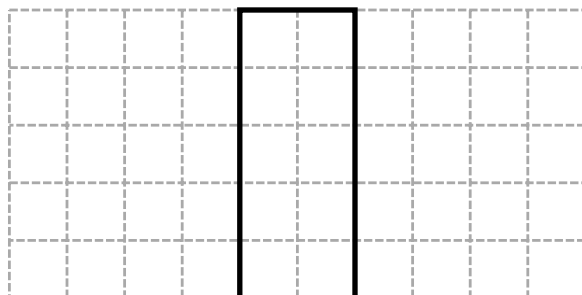
