## Multi Grid Greater-Than Sudoku

Each $4 \times 4$ grid has several greater-than signs representing digits greater-than other digits. Each grid also has several digits representing the difference (subtraction) between the two neighboring squares. Fill each square with a digit 1-4 so that each row and column of each $4 \times 4$ grid has each digit. Neighboring squares from separate grids do not have the same number. In addition, the 4 squares nearest the center of the puzzle must contain the set 1-4.
