The objective of this puzzle is to color the piece of fabric and insert 4 markers: the starting point (the star), the yarn (red line) and the two knitting needles (two black lines). Using logic and the clues above, determine the placement of such items.

Red and black line clues:
Use logic with these to figure out where the knitting needles and yarn are placed. Needles are always pointing downward at an increment of 22.5 degrees (below the horizon line where the star is).

Text based clues:
A letter number pair in a square indicates placement of a colored square. A number of degrees (an increment of 22.5 degrees) with two lines tells how far apart the knitting needles should be.

Color and star clues:
Use logic with these clue to figure out how to color the grid and where to place the star. Same colored squares from separate clues can overlap in the grid - find tile patterns that stick out in multiple clues.
