


The grids below represent top-down views of a mirror maze containing mirrors and monsters. The mazes are identical – they contain the same monsters, but the mirrors from the left side are rotated 90 degrees on the right side.

Eight (8) of the spaces are occupied by vampires – that is, their reflections cannot be seen in the mirrors of the maze.

Eight (8) of the spaces are occupied by ghosts – which cannot be seen head-on, only as reflections in mirrors of the maze.


Eight (8) of the spaces are occupied by zombies – they can be seen both head-on AND as reflections in mirrors of the maze.

The darkened (green) spaces inside the mazes all share the same entity; that is, all three are vampires, all ghosts, or all zombies. The number outside the maze represent the number of figures seen when peering into the maze – use these to identify the entities!




