
griddle Kakur 0-2-5

In this kakuro spin-off, fill the grid with zeros, twos, and fives so that each shape contains copies of the same digit and each clue is the sum of the partial row or column next to it, as in a standard kakuro or cross-sums puzzle. See example solution at bottom right, or try another 0-2-5 puzzle or kakuro puzzle before trying this one.

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Example solution. Note how the bottom row is split and each part has it's own sum.
