



Inspired by [Dr. Gareth Moore's Skyscraper Samurai Star Sudoku \(SSSS\)](#), this is a Size Six Skyscraper Samurai Star Sudoku. Solve the 5 overlapping 6x6 sudoku grids using the givens (in the form of a smile) in the center grid as well as the skyscraper clues around the outer edge of the puzzle.

Skyscraper clues: The 4 on the left means the viewer can see 4 buildings. On the right, the 3 means the viewer can see 3 buildings, since *one of the buildings is hidden behind another.*
