## griddle Story Logic



A group of 5 friends went on a road trip in an RV. Their destinations: 5 small out-of-the-way towns each with a roadside attraction/tourist trap turned destination, each with a place to swim, each with a silly kitschy t-shirt at the gift shop, and each with a great little dive restaurant that has a special you can't find anywhere else.

Ready to piece their trip back together? Use the clues on page 2 to match up who picked each of the destinations with their respective locations, food, $t$-shirts, and swimming spots.

In this puzzle, use the clues given to figure out which of the customers had which orders, and the items in each order. The logic grid has been given above to help sort out the puzzle's possible combinations.

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Clue 1: The shirts from the old timey soda museum and the place in the town of Landon were black and white, but not necessarily that order.

Clue 2: The sweet ol' BBQ ribs were the special item at either Miss Lily's or Eat ' $n$ ' Go, but not the special in the town of Mabel Hill.

Clue 3: The outdoor pool was in the town where the "pile-it-on" loaded fries were on special, which is not what Rafael picked.

Clue 4: Marco either picked the town where stew was on special and there was a water park at which to swim, or Teriville (home of The Purple Duck restaurant) but not both.

Clue 5: Rafael's pick was either a town with a famous steak sandwich special or a nice creek.

Clue 6: The hotel with an indoor pool was at the town where either the soda museum was located or the place that Olivia had picked.

Clue 7: The giant bear statue was in the same town as either Eat 'n' Go or Bubba's restaurant.

Clue 8: Max's was not in the same town as the lake.

Clue 9: The goldenrod shirt was from the attraction in the same town as either Miss Lily's or Bubba's.

Clue 10: Peter did not pick the town where Eat ' n ' Go is located.

Clue 11: Nadia did not choose St. Joseph or the place with red shirts.

In this puzzle, use the clues given to figure out which of the customers had which orders, and the items in each order. The logic grid has been given on page 1 to help sort out the puzzle's possible combinations.

Clue 12: The Radon 'health mine' was either located in Hillsdale or selling green t-shirts at the gift shop.

Clue 13: The Super Vortex gravity hill was in the same place as motel with the outdoor pool where the friends stayed.

Clue 14: Cosmic Mini Golf was not the attraction where the famous chili dogs were the special, nor was it where green or red shirts were sold.

Clue 15: The white t -shirt and super beefy stew were from the town where either a water park or lake were available for swimming.

Clue 16: The steak sandwich was not the special in Landon or Mabel Hill.

Clue 17: Either Peter or Rafael picked St. Joseph, but neither picked green shirts or the town with the chili dogs.

Clue 18: Olivia did not pick the town where The Purple Duck restaurant is located, nor did she pick Landon.

Clue 19: Peter's town choice was the town where you can find BBQ ribs.

Clue 20: The red shirts came from a town with Hill in the name.

Clue 21: The creek was located near the mine attraction, but not in the same town as the white shirts.

Clue 22: Eat ' $n$ ' Go was not the restaurant from the location with green shirts for sale.

Clue 23: Nadia and Peter picked the town with a lake and the town with the loaded fries, in some order.

Clue 24: The outdoor pool was not located in Landon or Teriville.

Clue 25: Marco picked the location that had white t-shirts, which was not Mabel Hill.

Clue 26: The gravity hill attraction, as you would expect by its name, is in one of the towns with Hill in it's name.

Clue 27: Miss Lily's is not in the same town as the soda museum.

Clue 28: The red $t$-shirts were from the attraction in the same town as Bubba's.

Clue 29: Neither the chili dog nor the loaded fries were from Eat ' n ' Go.

Clue 30: The Radon mine was not located in either Teriville or Landon.

Clue 31: The black t-shirts were from the location with an indoor pool.

Clue 32: Max's was in the same town as the outdoor pool or the creek.

Clue 33: Eat ' $n$ ' Go is not in Mabel Hill, nor is it in the same place as the Radon mine.

Clue 34: You (sadly) cannot find the amazing stew in the town of Hillsdale.
