


the griddle Shapeword

In Shapeword, solve the crossword puzzles by entering letters into the crossword grids, and solve the key grid by entering the proper letters. The letters entered into the crossword grid must correspond to the proper shape row or column in the key grid; in other words, the letter "I" may only be entered into **right triangles** or **circles** in the crossword grid. In the key grid, all 16 letters must be unique and have unique shape pairings. Once the key is solved, use it to decipher the final clue and solve the meta puzzle.
