

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Instructions

Each of the 5 overlapping 9x9 sudoku puzzles follow normal rules with the various clue types (below).

In the 3x3 squares with odd-sum and consecutive pair clues, all consecutive pairs and all odd-sum pairs are marked.





Sum Sudoku Clue: Sum of cells in the bordered area

Quad Given Clues: The 4 adjacent cells contain these digits

6	> 1 ·	3
2	5	4

Greater-Than Symbol: Notes which cell holds greater digit.

Consecutive Digits: Notes digits that are neighbors; 1|2, 5|6...



Pair with Odd Sum: Digits in the two cells have odd sum.

Difference of Pair: Difference between digits in cells.
