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Instructions

Today's piece displays consecutive clues. Place the shape sudoku lines and clue symbols into the grid marked '9' on your advent calendar sheet, and proceed to solve (as much as is possible) using the new clues.

Consecutive

Where two cells share a rectangle on their border, the cells are consecutively adjacent digits. (e.g. 1 and 2, 2 and 3, 5 and 6)

All clues possible within the white space are given, but clues possible on the grid's edge and green sections are not given.



Errata

The original posting of this grid had 4 instead of 14 in the bottom left area and two clues in incorrect spots.
