Instructions

Today's piece displays kropki clues. Place the shape sudoku lines and clue symbols into the grid marked '13' on your advent calendar sheet, and proceed to solve (as much as is possible) using the new clues.

Kropki

Where two cells share a white circle, the cells are consecutively adjacent digits. (e.g. 1 and 2, 2 and 3, 5 and 6)

Where two cells share a filled circle, one cell's digit is exactly 2x the other cell's digit.

A 1 and 2 adjacent to one another might have either type of clue.

All clues possible within this 6x6 space are given, but clues possible on the grid's edge are not given.
