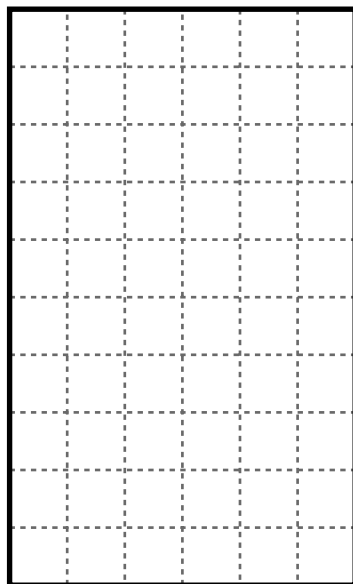


Instructions

Drop the tetromino pieces into the grid in the order given to spell 10 6-letter words.

The pieces may not be rotated or reflected and must be able to be dropped into the grid from the top, coming to rest on another piece (or the grid bottom).

Additional clues are given to identify the 10 words.
