






Archipelago

Each number is part of a rectangular island of that size. Islands must touch diagonally to form an archipelago, but cannot touch orthogonally. Empty 'water' squares cannot form 2x2 sections. Islands can be made without numbers to ensure that the islands all form a chain and there are no 2x2 water sections. Stars count as a 1-square island.
