
Instructions

In each 9x9 sudoku grid, fill each row, each column, and each 9-cell shape with one of each digit from 1 to 8 with no repeats. The cells with chess knights will not contain a digit.

The dashed-line sum cages are displayed with the sum of their digits in the topleft corner.

Chess knights are also placed throughout the grids and are displayed with the sum of the digits in the cells which they could attack, as shown below for reference.
