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Instructions

Each puzzle consists of a corral and latin square.


In each corral, create a single, closed loop along the grid. All clues must be inside the loop. The clues display the count of cells between it and the nearest fence in each cardinal direction, including the clue cell itself.

In each latin square, each row and column must contain each digit from 1 to 6 with no repeats.


When the corral is placed over the latin square, each column and row is split into sections.

The sections' sums have been partially provided, in the order displayed. Question marks denote a single unclued section. Stars denote one or more unclued sections occupying the given space.
