## Instructions

In each grid, blacken some cells such that they follow traditional heyawake rules:

Blackened cells may never touch one another in the four orthogonal directions.

White cells must form a completely connected

region throughout the grid.

A straight line of white cells must never cross more than one wall of the boldly-outlined rooms.

## The Twist

Instead of traditional heyawake number clues, each grid is marked with several sleeping cats.

So as to not disturb them, each cat nap cell must be left white, and must have exactly one neighboring cell left white, with all other orthogonallyneighboring cells black.

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
