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Instructions

In each grid, draw a single loop that visits each letter once, moving horizontally, vertically, or diagonally, without repeating letters or crossing itself.

Reading the letters along the loop must yield six words of six letters each. The six words start with a set of consecutive letters in alphabetical order, such as A, B, C, D, E, F.

After the final letter of the final word, the loop should connect back to the first letter of the first word.
