


Instructions



Branched Area 51


The original posting had a typo near the bottom, a 2 should've been a 3. Thanks to Cathy Saxton for reporting!

For Day 14's prompt, I made a regular slitherlink with no Area 51 twists, but the grid contains circles allowing for 'Irrational' clues.



#Enigmarch

This puzzle was created with the #Enigmarch series of puzzle construction prompts. Search for the hashtag on social media for more from other puzzle authors.

Irrational Slitherlink

The grid contains circles allowing for 'Irrational' clues to be given: the circumference of a circle with a radius of 1 grid unit is 2π .

Support TG

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The fence may not cross through the middle of the circles, nor may it use the edges of the bounding squares, as hinted by the L grid nodes pointing away from the circle.
